Getting started with GMID

Euromonitor International's Global Market Information Database is an integrated online information system providing business intelligence on countries, consumers and lifestyles

Searching the database

There are three ways to search the database. Use the menu search, the keyword search or the browse reports facility

Menu search
Select data from the geography AND category menus

Keyword search
The search box is accessed via the menu bar. The keyword search supports standard Boolean terms: AND, OR and AND NOT

Browse reports
Market reports can be accessed via the menu bar

Icons indicate the types of data available at every level: Statistics, Market reports, Companies and market share, Sources

Summary of selected items

Expands menus

Find data of interest within the category menu using the category filter function

Clear the category filter but not the selected items

Clear all selected items

Generate a list of results matching your selection

Search results

The list of search results provides a summary of the data matching the search criteria

Use the online tool box to create new datasets

If data are displayed in volume OR value data units you can create custom charts. Value data must be in a common currency

Currency conversions

Local currency • Euro • US dollar • Japanese yen • Swiss franc • British pound

Current/constant

Assess the impact of inflation by swapping from current (nominal) to constant (real) value data

Volume conversions

Litres • Hectolitres • UK/US barrels • Cases of different sizes

Unit multiplier

Thousands • Millions • Billions

Growth

Year-on-year growth • Period growth • Growth index

2.1 Population by Age

Overall, the Vietnamese population increased from 65 million persons in 1990 to 83 million in 2005, posting a growth of 27%. This total population is predicted to increase to more than 94 million in 2015, showing an increase of 44% compared to 1990, and about 21% compared to 2000.

The Vietnamese population is considered to be young based on the median age of less than 30 years. If the Vietnamese population was represented by a pyramid, it would have a narrow top and wide base, reflecting a country had relatively high fertility in the past. However, there is a tendency towards a narrowing base, which is shown by a decline in the percentage of the younger population from 1990. This shows that there has been a rapid decrease in fertility in the last decade. Vietnamese death rates have tended to decrease over the review period due to improved living standards and healthcare conditions, which make percentage of those who are over 80 years old increase from 0.7% in 1990 to 0.9% in 2005, and expected to increase to more than 1% in 2015.
